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## AGISTMENT OF HORSE ON PONY CLUB GROUNDS AGISTMENT RULES

1. Agistment is only available to financial members.
2. Members requesting Agistment for a horse must complete an Agistment Form and forward to the committee for approval.
3. Priority will be given to Junior members who are active participants in the club and to Club Instructors who have committed to run a minimum number of Rally Days per year.
4. Schedule of Agistment fees are \$25.00 a week per horse.
5. Agistment fees paid every 4 weeks, two weeks in advance plus a \$10 deposit for toilet key.
6. An invoice will be provided to the agistee by the F&DH&PC, payment can be made to the following account:

7. No more than 4 horses to be agisted at any one time (and no more than 2 by any one family) on a permanent basis and a waiting list is to be maintained by the Committee.
8. Placement is not transferable.
9. All horses must be immunized against hendra, tetanus and strangles annually (copy of vaccination certificate to be lodged with secretary)
10. All horses must be wormed every 12 weeks (or as recommended by vet).
11. Horses must be fed and checked on a daily basis.

12. Horses assessed by an appropriately qualified person (eg Club Chief Instructor or a veterinarian) as being in poor condition, will need prompt attention and the owner's expense.
13. Horse's water and troughs must be checked on a daily basis. Troughs need to be cleaned on weekly basis.
14. Stallions or rigs are not permitted
15. When the grounds are being used for official purposes, horses must be locked away and provided with suitable feed and water. For example on all rally days horses must be clear of the riding areas by start time.
16. The condition of the Jump Arena is not be unduly impacted upon by the agisted horses and may, from time to time, need to be kept horse-free if requested by the Committee.
17. It is recommended that a weekly roster system (or similar agreement) be set up between the agistees to promote equitable contribution to paddock upkeep including pickup of manure, cleaning of water troughs, and to check the fences and water lines. The roster should be lodged with the secretary. For a more serious maintenance problem, report to the maintenance coordinator or, if not available, the Committee.
18. Two horses per family only unless there is no one else on the waiting list.
19. In emergencies, a vet may be called on the owner's behalf and the owner is responsible for all cost incurred.
20. The F&DH&PC accept no responsibility for the welfare of the agisted horses while inside or outside the paddock.
21. Should any member fail to pay agistment as indicated by the rules, the Committee can decide to terminate the agistment agreement and the agistee will be required to remove the horse/s forthwith.
22. Ongoing payment of agistment does not constitute right of agistment if the Management Committee deems the agistee to be unsuitable for matters related to their Club membership (see Model Rules).
23. Breaches of any of the above will result in the cancellation of agistment privileges and the horses will need to be moved elsewhere at the owner's expense.
